The Case of "Magic-Nano"

German Federal Institute for Risk Assessment (BfR)

"According to the findings of the Federal Institute for Risk Assessment (BfR), nano particles are not the cause of the health disorders, in some cases severe, which occurred after using so-called sealing sprays. Based on the information from manufacturers and chemical studies commissioned by BfR, the products **do** not contain any nano-sized particles. The term "nano" in the product names is intended far more to draw attention to the wafer-thin film that forms on the surface of glass or ceramic after the spray-application of the products."
